

## JOB DESCRIPTION RUGBY COACH (BACKS SPECIALIST)

**Responsible to:** 

Director of Sport and Head of Rugby

Primary Responsibility:

The planning and coaching of rugby in the Senior School to include Saturday fixtures.

## Responsibilities:

The main responsibilities will include:

- Planning, delivering and leading high quality rugby sessions to Senior School pupils;
- Taking school teams for home and away fixtures, including Saturdays, and post-match teas (including driving pupils in a school minibus to and from fixtures, and umpiring);
- Delivering co-curricular clubs at lunchtime and after school as required;
- Leading squad training at lunchtime and after-school;
- To promote an ethos of good conduct on and off the field in all sports, and to promote high expectations and high levels of effort from all pupils;
- To ensure that our programme is fun and enjoyable for every single one of our pupils;
- To contribute to the staffing of trips and tours.

## <u>General</u>

- Promoting welfare and safety of all members of the school community, and adherence to the school's Safeguarding and Child Protection Policy;
- Support the aims of the school;
- Support all members of the school community with respect and consideration;
- Set a good example to pupils in terms of appropriate dress, standards of punctuality and attendance;

- Participate in the management of the school by attending meetings as required;
