NOTES FOR PARENTS

1. A candidate whose name has been registered is included in the examination list for the year of proposed entry as indicated by his/her parents. In the autumn preceding the year for which he/she is entered, the relevant details of his/her entrance examination are automatically sent to his/her parents so that they may decide whether he/she is to sit that year, or have his/her examination deferred to a later year. The same contact is made each autumn, if necessary.
2. The parents of a candidate who has been registered are asked to keep us informed of any change of address or change of school where the candidate is educated.
3. Parents are asked to keep the Head of the current school fully informed of plans to enter for an examination. We shall ask for a report from the school 6-8 weeks before the tests, as this will form part of our assessment.
