Dear Parents

As part of the Third Form (Year 7) Science Curriculum, we shall shortly be covering Human Development and Reproduction.

In particular, we shall be considering the changes that occur both physically and emotionally during puberty and adolescence. The teaching will be supplemented by a talk and question time that will concentrate on the emotional and practical problems that can be associated with this time of life. This session will be run by a specialist nurse and she will talk with small groups of boys and girls separately. The aim is to ensure that the pupils are prepared for these changes and accept them as a normal and natural part of growing up.
