WRITING

- Your opinion (Do you like the area? Do you prefer England? Why?)
- Are you going to return there? (Why/Why not?)
- Your activities (What did you do there? Opinions?)
- Your symptoms and how long you have felt this way. What remedies are you taking?
- Ask a question about your penfriend's holidays.

Remember to include past tense (perfect and imperfect), future tense (aller + infinitive) and try and show some Direct Object Pronouns, Demonstrative Adjectives and Imperatives too!
