Work your way through these units again, revising carefully the grammar and vocabulary covered in them.

The textbook Echo Express 2 has excellent grammar and vocabulary sections at the end of each unit and at the back of the book. It is also a good idea to make sure you are still confident on the basics of personal information, family etc.

You will be expected to recognize and be able to use the two main tenses:

Present Perfect

This year’s exam will be taken from the year end exam from Echo Express.

Speaking:

This will take place in lesson time during the week beginning 24th May. You will have to do a **presentation** on the topic of “**ein Ausflug**” lasting one minute. This must be from memory but you are allowed to have a small cue card of not more than 25 words to help you. You will then **answer 5** questions which will be taken from the list of 13 questions you have been preparing. It’s a good idea to try to expand your answers and

give opinions when answering the questions – extra marks will be given for expansion, pronunciation and accuracy!

Listening:

This will last approximately ½ hour and will be conducted during the exam week after half term.

Reading:

This is a ½ hour exam during the exam week after half term.

Writing:

This is also a ½ hour exam during the exam week. You will be writing answers based on topics we have covered this year, including a postcard and letter. It is important here to include both tenses and opinions. There will be a short grammar section in this exam too.
