## Girls' Uniform (Reception, Infant 1 and Infant 2)



(The Deputy Head (Academic) of the Preparatory School is the sole arbiter on matters of uniform and should be consulted if any clarification is required)

BLAZER\* Navy blue blazer with school badge. Pupils in Infant 1 and Infant 2 only. (Reception pupils may wear a

blazer in the summer term before they move into Infant 1 in the following September)

TUNIC\* Solihull tartan tunic. Length must be on or below the knee

BLOUSE White. Long or short sleeves with revere collar

CARDIGAN\* Regulation navy blue Solihull cardigan

SHOES Formal, black school shoes – must have Velcro fastening

SOCKS/TIGHTS Navy blue ankle or knee length socks or navy tights

SCARF\* Solihull regulation Preparatory School navy blue scarf (optional) HAT\* Solihull regulation Preparatory School navy blue hat (optional)

(These are the only scarf and hat to be worn)

GLOVES Navy blue

COAT\* Navy blue, waterproof, fleece-lined with school logo

ART\* Maroon waterproof art overall

OUTDOOR LEARNING\* Solihull regulation all in one waterproof suit

OTHER Navy Solihull regulation baseball cap (legionnaire style for Reception pupils)

Regulation long sleeved cotton lunch overall – blue check (Reception and Infant 1 pupils only)

Navy Solihull regulation book bag

Wellingtons (any colour)

Water bottle (own choice) - reusable and sturdy

SPORT\* Solihull regulation Infant backpack (embroidered with crest and number)

White Solihull regulation PE t- shirt

White PE ankle socks

Navy blue shorts

Solihull regulation navy and maroon swimming costume

Solihull regulation navy blue swimming hat

Towel (any colour)

Trainers - Velcro fastening only

Solihull regulation navy blue infant tracksuit

Please note: all pupils need a spare pair of named socks and underwear, which should be kept in their PE rucksack. Reception pupils will also require a set of spare warm clothes (not uniform) for Forest School e.g., joggers/leggings and a jumper/sweatshirt. These will be kept in school. Drawstring swimming bags are NOT permitted. Pumps are not required – pupils will wear their trainers instead.

JEWELLERY Jewellery is not permitted, except for a single pair of discreet stud earrings, one in each lobe. Jewellery must

be removed for Games, PE and Swimming lessons. Piercings covered by a plaster are not permitted. Make-

up and nail varnish are not permitted.

HAIR Hair should be of conventional cut and neat and tidy at all times. During the working day the overall effect

should be one that is in keeping with the standards of the school and with health and safety considerations. The dyeing of hair is not permitted. If hair is shoulder length or longer, it must all be tied back off the face. Hair

accessories must be discreet, moderately sized and navy or maroon.
