TROUSERS*	Dark grey trousers (boys may wear dark grey shorts in the summer term)
SHIRT	Formal shirt in plain white. Sleeves may be long or short
TIE*	School regulation tie – pre-tied, on elastic
SWEATER*	Navy sweater or slipover with school logo
SHOES	Formal, black school shoes – must have Velcro fastening
SOCKS	Grey, knee length or ankle socks

During the working day the overall effect should be one that is in keeping with the standards of the school and with health and safety considerations. The dyeing of hair is not permitted. Styles should not be extreme (e.g. a marked difference between length on sides/top). Hair gel/wax is not permitted.
