



SOLIHULL

EYFS Uniform (Nursery and Reception)

(The Deputy Head (Pastoral) of the Preparatory School is the sole arbiter on matters of uniform and should be consulted if any clarification is required)

UNIFORM	Navy joggers Solihull regulation navy sweatshirt Solihull regulation maroon polo shirt Navy shorts – (to be worn in the summer term instead of joggers)
SOCKS	Navy socks – ankle or knee length
SHOES	Formal, black school shoes (no adornments/lights) – must be Velcro fastening. (Slip on, boots and trainer styles are not permitted)
COAT	Navy blue, waterproof, fleece-lined with school logo
HAT	Solihull regulation navy fleece hat (scarves are NOT permitted in EYFS)
SPORT	Black PE pumps (Velcro fastening) and additional Velcro trainers in the summer term. Navy regulation rucksack for swimming kit Navy one-piece swimming costume, trunks or jammers Solihull regulation navy swimming hat Swimming goggles (not mask style) Towel (any colour)
OUTDOOR LEARNING	Solihull regulation waterproof navy all in one suit for outdoor learning
OTHER	Regulation long sleeved cotton lunch overall Regulation waterproof maroon art overall Solihull regulation navy sun hat (legionnaire style) Solihull regulation navy book bag Navy 'string' mittens (own choice, not gloves - optional) Wellington boots (own choice) Water bottle (own choice, reusable and sturdy)

Please note: all children in EYFS need a spare pair of named socks and underwear, and a set of spare uniform (joggers, polo shirt and sweatshirt), which should be kept in school in a Solihull regulation named drawstring bag. Swimming kit should be kept in the sports rucksack.

JEWELLERY Jewellery is not permitted except for a small pair of simple gold or silver stud earrings, one in each ear lobe, which must be removed by parents and carers on the day of their child's swimming lesson. Piercings covered by a plaster are not permitted. Nail varnish and make up is not permitted. Smart watches are not permitted.

HAIR Hair should be neat, off the face and of an appropriate style, length and colour. If hair is shoulder length or longer, it must all be tied back in a ponytail or plait. Hair accessories must be discreet, moderately sized and navy or maroon. Styles should not be extreme (e.g., a marked difference between length on sides/top). Hair gel/wax and the dyeing of hair are not permitted. Religious head coverings should be navy blue. During the working day the overall effect should be one that is in keeping with the standards of the school and with health and safety considerations.

Please ensure all items of uniform and sports kit are named, including footwear.
