



## SOLIHULL

### Girls' Uniform (Junior School)

(The Deputy Head (Pastoral) of the Preparatory School is the sole arbiter on matters of uniform and should be consulted if any clarification is required)

BLAZER	Navy blue blazer with school badge.
SKIRT	Solihull tartan pleated skirt. ( <b>Length must be on or below the knee.</b> )
BLOUSE	Plain white shirt <b>with revere collar</b> . Sleeves may be long or short.
SWEATER	Solihull regulation navy blue sweater or slipover
SHOES	Formal, black school shoes – Velcro, buckle or laces fastening (if pupils are able to tie their own laces.) <b>(Slip on styles, boots and trainer styles are not permitted)</b>
SOCKS/TIGHTS	Navy blue ankle or knee length socks or navy tights.
SCARF	Solihull regulation Preparatory School navy blue scarf (optional).
HAT	Solihull regulation Preparatory School navy blue hat (the only scarf and hat to be worn.)
GLOVES	Navy blue (optional)
COAT	Solihull regulation navy blue, waterproof, fleece-lined coat
ART	Waterproof art overall
SCHOOL BAG	Solihull regulation rucksack – numbered with crest

### SPORT

SHIRT	School regulation PE polo shirt.
TRACKSUIT	School regulation challenger style tracksuit pants School regulation full zip storm jacket (Hoodie styles are not permitted)
SKORT	School regulation, navy.
LEGGINGS	School regulation, navy blue.
SOCKS	School regulation hockey socks. White ankle socks for PE, netball and summer sports.
BASE LAYER	School regulation, navy top and leggings (optional)
FOOTWEAR	Sports trainers (Astro shoes are recommended for J4 team hockey players)
SHINPADS	Required for hockey and football.
MOUTHGUARD	A mouthguard is compulsory for hockey/rugby and a custom-made one can be ordered via the school in the first week of the Christmas term.
SWIMWEAR	One-piece navy costume
SWIM HAT	School regulation, navy.
CAP	School regulation baseball cap (the only cap to be worn)
TOWEL	Any colour (Swimming kit to be kept inside kit bag in a waterproof drawstring bag)
KIT BAG	School regulation kit bag
WATER BOTTLE	Own Choice. Reusable and sturdy.

**Please note: all pupils need a spare pair of named socks and underwear, which should be kept in their kit bag.  
Please ensure all items of uniform and sports kit are named, including footwear.**

### Girls' Uniform (Junior School)

#### JEWELLERY

Jewellery is not permitted, except for a single pair of discreet, simple, stud earrings, one in each lower ear lobe. Jewellery must be removed for Games, PE and Swimming lessons. Piercings covered by a plaster are not permitted. Make-up and nail varnish are not permitted. Smart watches are not permitted.

#### HAIR

Hair should be neat, off the face and of an appropriate style, length and colour. If hair is shoulder length or longer, it must all be tied back in a ponytail or plait. Hair accessories must be discreet, moderately sized and navy or maroon. Styles should not be extreme (e.g., a marked difference between length on sides/top). Hair gel/wax and the dyeing of hair are not permitted. Religious head coverings should be navy blue. During the working day the overall effect should be one that is in keeping with the standards of the school and with health and safety considerations.
