Our Outdoor Education programme includes a wide range of age-appropriate adventures - from woodland exploration and shelter building to team challenges, nature walks and outdoor cooking. These activities not only support physical development but also help pupils build important life skills such as communication, leadership, and problem-solving.

Whether it's taking part in our Forest School, growing food in our gardens, organising and implementing a recycling/upcycling project, litter-picking, learning about sustainability or experiencing their first overnight residential trip, pupils are encouraged to step outside their comfort zone in a safe and supportive environment.

Each year group enjoys opportunities to learn and grow in nature, with experiences carefully planned to foster independence, curiosity, and a sense of achievement.

# PERFORMING ARTS


